**Artience Lighting** now open at 3512 Seagate Way in the Seagate Business Park.

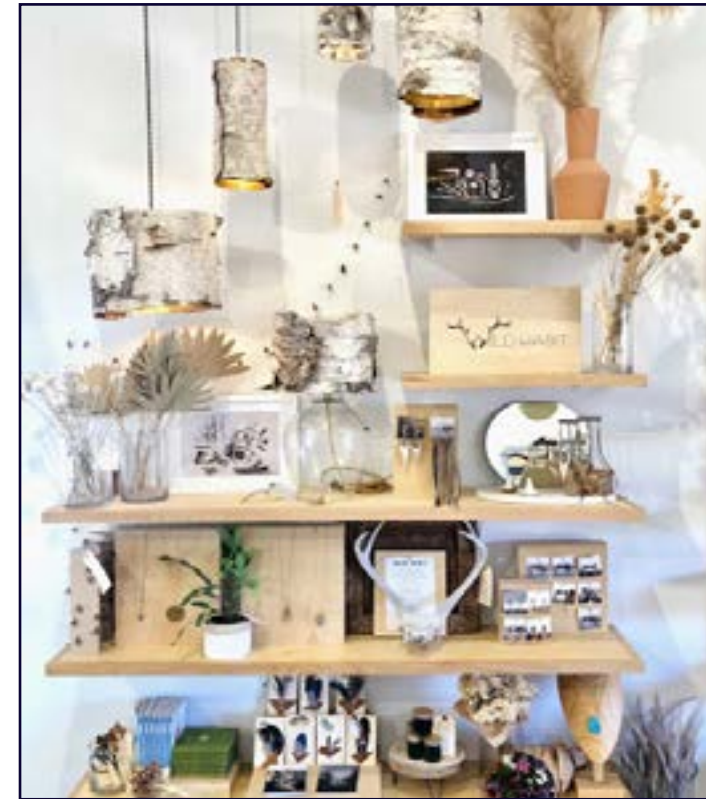
**Job Ambience** has leased 1,912 sq. ft. at 4095 Oceanside Blvd., Ste K in the Rancho del Oro Business Park.
