OCEANSIDE SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS

A partnership of the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce, MainStreet Oceanside and the City of Oceanside.

On March 11, 2021, the **American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)** was signed into law, allocating \$32.3 million of Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to the City of Oceanside. As part of its ARPA spending plan, the Oceanside City Council approved \$300,000 to be used for grants to businesses negatively impacted by COVID-19.

The City is partnering with MainStreet Oceanside and the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce to manage the grant program. The application period is **OPEN now through NOVEMBER 19, 2021.**

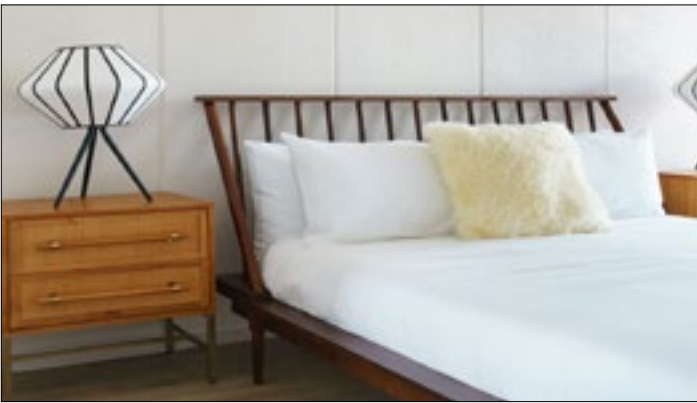
